Dear Premier Horgan,

Earlier this year, there was a roundtable on the Great Bear Rainforest that was co-sponsored by the environmental group Canopy, and the Globe and Mail. Participants heard from the BC Government, local Indigenous leaders, forestry company representatives, scientists, and environmental groups about the progress that is being made to protect this forest. We understand that there have been some delays in fulfilling the commitments made and hoped to hear that these efforts were back on track.

We are concerned to learn that the areas that were intended to be designated for protection have not been completed. We also heard that some important areas of old growth forests in British Columbia, outside the Great Bear Rainforest, are being logged. Our company, E.MIROGLIO EAD is committed to manufacturing our products using dissolving pulp produced by wood from countries/regions/ that are meeting high environmental standards.

We also support environmental initiatives that safeguard the health of important ecosystems and all efforts to reduce climate changes.
